



2010 Road America Vintage Sports Car Races

Where

Elkhart Lake, Road America and surrounding areas are easy to access from Minneapolis/St. Paul via Interstate 94 east to Wisconsin Highway 82 at Mauston. Highway 82 east becomes Highway 23 and continues east to Elkhart Lake in Sheboygan County. The drive is approximately five hours. There are certainly more scenic routes if driving I-94 is not to your liking. Contact Brent Poppenhagen for suggested route information.

Why

Road America was developed in 1955 in the rolling kettle moraine landscape of Sheboygan County Wisconsin. For over fifty years it has been a favorite circuit for sports car racing and now for the fast growing phenomenon of vintage sports car racing. Road America is a 628-acre, world-class facility featuring a 4.048 mile road course near the town of Elkhart Lake.

How

Each race weekend involves two or three days of time trials, practice and racing events, Thursday or Friday through Sunday. Time trials and practice sessions are held on Thursdays and Fridays. Racing and time trials are generally held on Saturdays. Races are held all day on Sundays. A great weekend can be had by setting out from the Twin Cities on Friday and returning on Sunday or by setting out on Saturday and returning Monday.

If you can invest a little more time, you might wish to visit the City of Sheboygan water front on Lake Michigan with its yacht marina, commercial and sports fishing fleet and many fine restaurants and bars. The Kohler Art Center (one the finest regional galleries in America) is a must see attraction as is the Village of Kohler with its American Club, restaurants and pubs, six golf courses, and specialty shopping at the Shops at Woodlake.

What (does it cost?)

Tickets range from \$40 - \$80 for a full three-day event but are reasonably priced at \$10 - \$40 for single day tickets. A wide variety of accommodations are available at motels and resorts in Sheboygan and Fond du Lac counties. Tent camping and motorhome camping are available within the Road America venue itself.
